

VILLAGE OF CULLOM ORDINANCES

CHAPTER 15

BURNING REGULATIONS

Section I: No person shall kindle any acceptable fire or authorize any such fire to be kindled or maintained on any private land unless the location is not less than twenty-five (25) feet from any structure and adequate provision is made to prevent the fire from spreading to within twenty-five (25) feet of any structure.

Section II: An adult shall constantly attend all acceptable fires until such fire is extinguished. This person shall have a garden hose connected to the water supply or other fire extinguishing equipment ready for use.

Section III: Rubbish fires including tires, roofing materials, building materials, rags, straw, or any material giving off an obnoxious odor are not permitted.

Section IV: No burning may be done upon the paved portion of any street or sidewalk.

Section V: No burning shall be done at any time or place when the wind conditions may create a nuisance to anyone or the property of anyone in the vicinity or to any person in the vicinity.

Section VI: No person shall burn leaves or other materials between the hours of sunset and sunrise.

Section VII: (*Acceptable to Burn*)

1. Leaves
2. Yard Waste
3. Fire Pit
4. Recreation Fire

Section VII: *(Non-Acceptable to Burn)*

1. Rubbish
2. Building or Construction Materials
3. Garbage or Rags
4. Any material providing obnoxious odors
5. Bonfire

Section VIII: Fire Pits shall be no more than four (4) feet in diameter.

Section IX: *(Penalty)* Any person, firm, or corporation, who violates, omits, neglects, or refuses to comply with, or who resists the enforcements of any of the provisions of this ordinance shall, upon conviction, be fined no less than five hundred dollars nor more than five thousand dollars for each offense. Each subsequent day of a violation shall constitute a separate offence under the terms of this ordinance.
