**ORDINANCE UPDATING TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICES
AND ESTABLISHING NO OVERNIGHT PARKING AREAS**

WHEREAS the Board of Trustees of the Village of Cullom, Illinois finds that it is in the best interest of the Village to establish certain traffic control devices within the Village limits of Cullom, Illinois; and

WHEREAS the Board of Trustees of the Village of Cullom wishes to establish no overnight parking areas within the Village of Cullom, Illinois,

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by the President and the Board of Trustees of the Village of Cullom, Livingston County, Illinois as follows:

1. That the two stop signs located at the intersection of Jeffrey and Bass, placed upon the East/west direction of said intersection shall be placed, in the Village of Cullom, Illinois shall be replaced with speed limit signs;
2. That the stop sign located on Bass Street going North at the intersection of Jeffrey and Bass, in the Village of Cullom, Illinois shall be replaced with a Yield sign;
3. That four School Zone Ahead signs shall be placed as close as possible to the designated distance of 200 feet from the school property at the following locations:
 - A. Northbound on Maple Street;
 - B. Eastbound on VanAlstyne Street;
 - C. Northbound on Walnut Street (to be places slanted from the Co-Op Office); and
 - D. Northbound on Walnut Street (across the tracks near the woodworking Building).
4. Any and all outdated signs shall be replaced with MUTCD approved signs
5. The following areas within the Village of Cullom, Illinois shall be designated "No Overnight Parking Areas" and appropriate signage shall be placed designating same:
 - A. Hack Street on both sides of the street between Oak Street and Maple Street;
 - B. Oak Street on both sides in front of the Community Center going North on Oak Street; and
 - C. The East side of Jeffrey Street from the present Handicap parking space to Oak Street.


The No Overnight Parking Areas shall be for the period from 1:00 Am until 6:00 am. All violators of the No Overnight Parking shall be assessed a fine in the amount of \$100.00.

6. The expenditures required to purchase said signs are hereby approved;
7. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval in the manner provided by law.
