Minutes: Approved by consent agenda. Motion Made by Rock/Meister. M/C

Maintenance Report: Lovell reported the following for the month:

- Ameren was contacted about the Christmas Light bill. The village will be credited \$190.64 for service that was billed after the power was to be shut off.
- Will be meeting with Ameren about tree removal in the village.
- Explained state-wide testing of lead/copper in water.
- Reported on water leaks in the village.

Attorney Report: Attorney Gabor reported on ongoing village litigations. Rock/Mills made the motion that recommendations discussed be put into effect. All voted in favor and M/C.

Treasure Report: Approved as presented.

Clerk Report: Motion to pay all bills \$15,245.92 was made by Krause/Wallrich. All voted in favor and M/C.

Old Business:

- MFT street repairs will proceed as discussed.
- Sidewalk on south side of Main Street will proceed as discussed.
- Whitman/Rock made the motion to proceed with the repairs on Cherry/Cleveland Street as presented in an estimate from Haley Brothers. The property owners will pay expenses. All voted in favor and M/C.
- Lovell will talk with Hack about the drainage problem by his property.
- The Medicom ordinance was tabled until next meeting.

New Business:

- Rock/Mills made the motion to accept the prevailing wage ordinance. All voted in favor and M/C.

Any Other Business:

Richard Stover requested that he be able to erect a tent on village property on the west end of Main Street during the celebration. He will be advised to contact the Citizen's for Cullom to ask for approval.

Job Dunlevey, a Tri-Point High School student has been named the State Champion Bare Back Rider. His family asked permission to erect a banner on the edge of town. Permission was given.
