

Streets/Alleys/Public Property Committee Meeting March 11, 2015

The meeting was called to order at 6:30 PM. With the consent of the committee, the Allyn's were allowed to address the problem with flooding on their property at 206 North Elm Street. They offered an easement to the Village to help with drainage and willing to help with cost. This may eliminate some problems however, won't solve completely due to the water coming from north of town.

Deany was instructed to investigate and determine any solutions.

Krause and Mr. & Mrs. Allyn left meeting.

2015 Street Maintenance: Deany presented map of Street Work Rotation Plan with different options and prices. After discussion on four different options; the Committee determined with higher probability of price increased in the future to do Option 1 <Blue> at an estimated cost of \$28,749 and instructed Deany to have MFT paperwork ready for regular scheduled March board meeting. No decision was made on Spray Patch work.

2015 Sidewalk Maintenance: Discussion on the south side of Hack Street <Main business district> as to replacing sidewalk. The east end will not be a major project as the west end to be ADA compliant. Still to be determined would be contributions of businesses to be ADA compliant with their access. Deany was instructed to get a survey to start a plan on what will need to be done.

2015 Alley Maintenance: Lovell suggested a yearly rotation plan similar to the Street Maintenance to re-gravel and grade alleys. He has begun a plan on which alleys to work on first. The largest expense will be gravel. He also recommended South Ash Street needs to be built up with gravel.

2015 Tree Maintenance: Lovell would like to hire two high school students on a trial basis this summer to work with him. He can cut branches and they can pick up for burning.

Village Park Maintenance: It was decided to contact the Fair Board to get the buildings cleaned out. Also, to see if they could help with time and materials for repairing buildings. Wood building has holes to be repaired.

Any other business: The ditch needs to be replaced <dug out> at the Hack Street Apartments on South Elm and Cleveland. Water is standing on the road after a rain. Work needs to be done as soon as possible weather permitting.

With no other business, the meeting was adjourned at 8:30 PM
