**Public:** Ron Ellis, Field Representative Organizer for Laborers International Union of North America Local Union #996 addressed the board concerning the Southside Business District Sidewalk Project.

**Business to be Addressed:**

- Deany recommended Rupprecht Concrete to complete the Southside Business District Sidewalk Project. Whitman/Meister made the motion to accept Rupprecht Concrete bid of \$45,526.00 for the project. All voted in favor and M/C. Work will be done after the Cullom Celebration in August.
- Wallrich/Whitman made the motion to accept the bid from General Materials for the village MFT street repairs for a total of \$37,404.95. \$980 of this amount will be taken from the General Fund to pay for PEP material. All voted as in favor except for Rock who abstained from the vote.
